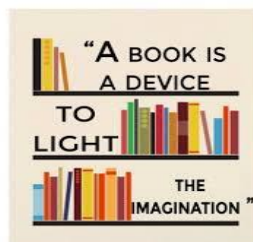




A Bullet-Point Guide to Accelerated Reader

Accelerated Reader encourages children to read independently. It doesn't replace the teaching of reading. It allows children to quiz on books pitched at their individual reading ability:

- The students do an online **Star Reading** assessment. It is a 34 question, computer adaptive assessment. This determines what level of book they read. Students are given their **ZPD**, a number to guide their choice of text.
- 38,000 books have been given a level based on complexity, level of vocabulary, average sentence/word length etc.
- The student selects a book within that level to read. The book might come from school, home, local library or digitally via SORA, BorrowBox etc. They can listen to the book as an audiobook also.
- **Students must read for a minimum of 25 minutes a day.**
- Within 24 hours of reading the book, students must quiz to check for understanding. This is an online quiz that can be done on PC, laptop, iPad etc.
- Students must **get at least 60%** in a quiz to have passed it.
- The system will set students a **differentiated** point target to reach. They gain points by passing quizzes.
- Very soon we hope to have a reward system up and running for students who are meeting their targets. **Rewards are for students of all levels and abilities.** We will reward students who are working to the best of their own ability.
- After a period of time (often 6/7 weeks) the students take a new Star Reading assessment. They will then be given a new, usually higher, level of books to read. This way they are always being extended.

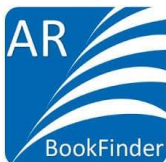


Websites and Apps for First Years

This is the unique URL for our students. This is the website they use for the STAR Testing and Quizzing on books. They click the Blue Box when they do a STAR Test, and Orange Box to take a quiz. Students are also encouraged to read and quiz on the articles and non-fiction texts on the site.

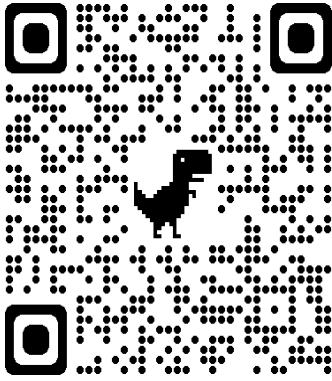

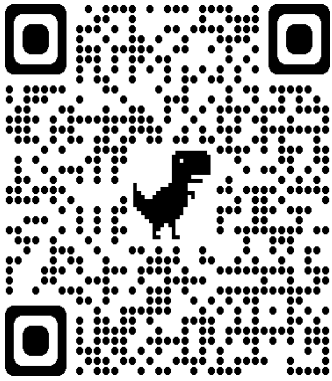

The wonderful librarians in Kerry Library, have just provided us with usernames and passwords for all our First Year students. This is yet another resource for students to access books they want to read.

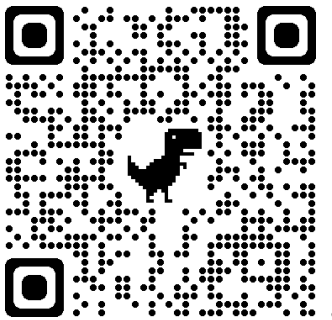
